Addendum No. 1

The following questions were submitted. The City's responses to the questions follow in *Italics*.

- 1. Q: Are there historical or recent test results for dissolved oxygen at the outlet of the detention pond?

A: The dissolved oxygen results are historical and were obtained by the Maine DEP. The Maine DEP conducted water quality analyses April 1, 2011 through the end of August 2011. The Capehart Brook summary report prepared by the DEP concludes that although conductivity and temperature are not limiting factors to Capehart Brook, dissolved oxygen appears to be a concern. The 2011 summary report further mentions a potential "wetland effect" caused by the "wetland" adjacent to Ohio Street. The "wetland" referred to in the summary report is the failing pond known as Sunny Hollow.

- 2. Q: Have target values for dissolved oxygen been established?

A: Dissolved oxygen target values of 7mg/l or higher are ideal. The goal of the pond retrofit is to provide movement and aeration thus increasing dissolved oxygen levels.

- 3. Q: Is there a cost estimate?

A: The cost estimate should not exceed \$6,000.00
