The following questions were submitted following the mandatory pre-bid meeting. The City's responses to the questions follow in *Italics*.

1. Q: Burn Building Sprinkler Repair Allowance- \$800.00: Was this agreed upon amount to carry as the allowance?

A: There is no clearly defined amount. Some people used that number in the pre-bid meeting but it is not a firm amount.

2. Q: Will Owner perform electrical work for the Classroom heat pump?

A: Yes.

3. Q: Will the existing door hardware (hinges, locksets) at the Classroom building be reused?

A: The locksets are likely fine to reuse. New hinges will be required.

4. Q: How many toilet stalls are required in each bathroom?

A: 1 per bathroom

5. Q: Burn Building Shutters- Are the exterior, steel window shutters to be considered as part of the Painting Scope of Work?

A: Yes

6. Q: Can you specify what insurance and bonding requirements are in place for this project?

A: The City will not require a bid or performance bond for this project, however, a standard Certificate of Insurance covering general liability,

workers' compensation, automobile liability, etc. is required. This will be addressed prior to the execution of the contract.

7. Burn Building Masonry- Is repointing of the masonry to be included in the Scope of Work?

A: No significant work. However, bidders should expect there may be some related work on the masonry block building that must be completed for essential purposes.

All other terms, conditions and specifications remain the same.
