I. Introduction

The City of Bangor requests bids to furnish and deliver two (2) heavy duty, Truck Mounted Portable Hot Patcher to the Fleet Maintenance Facility, FOB destination, 481 Maine Avenue, Bangor, Maine. The equipment must be furnished and delivered in accordance with the attached specifications and following conditions. These units must be the most current year machine available.

II. General Information

General information is available on the City's website at the following web address: www.bangormaine.gov/bids/proposals. By submitting a response to this solicitation, the bidder accepts the responsibility for downloading, reading and bidding by the terms and conditions set forth in the City's "General Information for Vendors". All questions shall be directed in writing to bids@bangormaine.gov.

III. Submission

To be considered, please return pages three (3) and four (4) including the Bid Form (page 5) in an envelope clearly marked "**Bid No.: B16-004: Hot Patcher**" by **2:00 PM, Wednesday, July 22, 2015** to the Purchasing Department, City Hall, 73 Harlow Street, Bangor, Maine 04401.

Bids may also be submitted via email by using the link at the top of this page or by sending to: bids@bangormaine.gov. If emailing bid, please reference "**Bid No.: B16-004: Hot Patcher**" in the subject line. Bids will be publicly opened at the time stated above.

A tabulation of all bids received will be available after 3:00 PM on the date of opening. Bid results may be viewed by visiting the City's website at www.bangormaine.gov/Bids/Proposals/Results.

IV. Questions

Any questions must be directed in writing to bids@bangormaine.gov no later than **4:30 PM, Monday, July 13, 2015**.

The City will issue a response to any questions or inquiries submitted in writing by the date above, on or before **4:30 PM, Wednesday, July 15, 2015**. The response will be in the form of an addendum, which will be available on the City's website.

V. Award

The bid award will be based on the following criteria:

- Cost of ownership of the equipment;
- Quality and performance of equipment offered;
- Availability of equipment; and
- Prior history or experience with the Bidder, and/or prior history or experience with the equipment offered.

VI. Information for Bidders

1. A space is provided for the Bidder to list the specifications of their equipment under "Vendor Specs".
2. Pages three (3) and four (4) of this request must be completed and returned with all questions answered in order to be considered.
3. Any exception to the provisions in the specifications must be marked in the body of this document and itemized on a separate page titled "Exceptions", referenced by section number and paragraph, along with a detailed explanation of the exception.
4. The entire units and all equipment must be thoroughly inspected, serviced and ready for use upon delivery. All work performed must meet established industry standards of quality to be acceptable. Any unacceptable work must be corrected before payment is issued.
5. All Federal and State taxes must be excluded from the bid price. A tax exemption certificate for the City of Bangor shall be furnished to the successful Bidder upon request.
6. It is understood that this will be operated by City personnel for general construction work and other purposes for which the equipment is designed.

VII. Specifications

The Specifications listed below under "Requested Specifications" represent the City's basic requirements for the equipment requested. The specifications should be viewed as a guideline for the City's needs and not an absolute minimum or maximum requirement. Alternate specifications will be considered but may not be accepted. The City will purchase the equipment that will best meet the requirements of the Bangor Fleet Services Division.

In order to be considered bidders must list the specifications of their equipment under "Vendor Specs". This unit must be manufactured for year round road maintenance and paving programs.

This machine must be capable of:

- 1. Recycling virgin hot mix, non virgin asphalt RAP and clean millings
- 2. Holding and transporting hot mix for days
- 3. Heating and reheating cold patch

- A. The intent of this specification is to purchase two (2) two (2) ton Slip in Hot Patcher such as a Spaulding or Falcon or approved Equal.
