

City of Bangor  
**Ordinance**

**BANGOR CITY CODE**

Buildings shall have approved address numbers, building numbers or approved building identification placed in a position that is plainly legible and visible from the street or road fronting the property. These numbers shall contrast with their background. Address numbers shall be a minimum of 4 inches high with a minimum stroke width of ½ inch.
