

What is the City of Bangor Safety Award Program?

The Safety Award Program was started as a way to reward employees for working safely and avoiding work place injuries or illnesses. Not only are the awards issued on a quarterly basis (*every three months*), but they are also awarded annually to all employees in a City Department that does not have a loss time, work-related injury or illness for the previous quarter or calendar year.

What are Safety Certificates?

Safety Certificates are points that come in increments of 25 points quarterly and 75 points annually which can be redeemed for cool merchandise.

How do I redeem my Safety Certificates?

The City has partnered with Advertising Specialists of Maine to provide a catalog of various merchandise. Each piece of merchandise has a point value assigned to it, which allows you to determine how many certificates you will need to redeem to purchase the item. Please follow the instructions on the back of your certificate to redeem them for merchandise.

Can I save my Certificates for Larger Point Items?

You can! Previous certificates had an expiration date of 36 months. The City has eliminated the expiration date, allowing employees to save certificates and redeem them for merchandise with a higher point value.
