2. Air Service Development update

Airport Director Caruso indicated that he and Risteen met with United Airlines. They made a presentation for the Bangor to Chicago route. It was a positive meeting, but non committal. Bangor is competing with other Airports. The Airlines are not adding flights, but in certain markets are adding capacity. If Bangor was to pick up this service another community would lose this service. United is looking at other Airports that are not performing to their expectations. This could be a long process of months to years. They are impressed with Bangor for our connections with China and the exchange school population. They will continue to follow up with United.

3. Presentation by C & L Aerospace President, Chris Kilgour

Airport Director, Caruso introduced, Chris Kilgour, the president/owner of C & L Aerospace. C & L started operations in Bangor 2009 with 22 employees and have quickly grown.. This expansion will give additional job growth in the Market. It is a MRO which will offer aircraft painting. Chris, made a ten minute video presentation to the Committee, explaining the services they offer. They currently have 90 people employed and they plan to hire more with the next few years. C & L Aero Space is a 24/7 service. It is a one stop shop for regional aircraft for a 30-70 seat jets/prop. The Business was started about 20 years ago and it started just with parts. They specialize in the saab 340 and storing and selling of aircrafts. They work on maintenance, parts and leasing of aircrafts.
