
CITY OF BANGOR Financial Statement

The validity of the bonds and of the voters' ratification of the bonds may not be affected by any errors in the estimate made above. If the actual amount of the total debt service of the bond issue varies from the estimate, the ratification by the electors is nevertheless conclusive and the validity of the bond issue is not affected by reason of the variance.
