Bids are requested for the

UNION STREET RESURFACING II PROJECT

MDOT PROJECT NUMBER STP-1864(000)X/ NHPP-1864(200)X

The project includes the milling and placing new hot mix asphalt surface on a portion of Union Street in Bangor, Maine, and will include some storm drain and catch basin replacement, curb replacement, sidewalk overlay, and sidewalk detectable warning ramps, along with other incidental work.

The Union Street Resurfacing II Project is a Maine Federal Aid Project No. STP 1864(000)X/ NHPP 1864(200)X, MDOT WIN 18640.00/ 18642.00, located along a portion of Union Street starting at Sixteenth Street and extending westerly 1.24 miles to Griffin Road, Bangor, Maine.

A **prebid meeting** will be held on April 28, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. at the City of Bangor's Engineering Department, 73 Harlow Street, Bangor, Maine.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the bid price will be required in the form of cash, a certified check or bid bond.

This project is subject to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wage Rate Determination. All work shall be governed by State of Maine Department of Transportation, "Standard Specification", revision of November 2014, and "Standard Details", revision of November 2014.

The right is reserved by the City of Bangor to reject any and all bids or to waive informalities or defects in bids if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Bangor. Bases of award of Contract is determined by the lowest qualified bidder. **The lowest bidder must have completed, or successfully completed a Highway construction, paving or project specific prequalification from MDOT to be considered for the award of this contract.**
