I. Introduction

The City of Bangor requests bids to furnish and deliver a 2016 4x4 Yukon XL SLE or Suburban LS or equivalent, FOB Destination to the Bangor International Airport. The vehicle shall be new, current year truck furnished and delivered in accordance with the attached specifications. The City will consider alternate bids for the purchase of unsold 2015 model if they meet or exceed the requested specifications.

II. General Information

General information is available on the City's website at the following web address: www.bangormaine.gov/proposals. By submitting a response to this solicitation, the bidder accepts the responsibility for downloading, reading and bidding by the terms and conditions set forth in the City's "General Information for Vendors".

III. Submission

To be considered, return pages 4-9 of this Request for Bids in an envelope clearly marked "**Vehicle Bid- BIA**" by **2:00 PM, Wednesday, July 13, 2016** to the Purchasing department, City Hall, 73 Harlow Street, Bangor, Maine 04401.

Bids may also be submitted via email by using the link at the top of this page or by sending to: bids@bangormaine.gov. If emailing bid, please reference "**Vehicle Bid- BIA**" in the subject line. Bids will be publicly opened at the time stated above.

A tabulation of all bids received will be available within 24 hours from the time of opening. Bid results may be viewed by visiting the City's website at www.bangormaine.gov/proposals.

IV. Questions

Any questions must be directed in writing to bids@bangormaine.gov no later than 4:30 PM on Tuesday, July 5, 2016.

The City will issue a response to any questions or inquiries submitted in writing by the date above, on or before 4:30 PM, Thursday, July 7, 2016. The response will be in the form of an addendum, which will be available on the City's website.

V. Late Bids

It is the responsibility of the Bidder(s) to see that their bids have sufficient time to be received by the Purchasing Department before the submittal deadline.

Any bid, portion of a bid, or unrequested bid revision received at the City of Bangor Purchasing Department after the time and date specified, will be return to the Bidder(s) unopened.

VI. Withdrawal of Bids

No Bidder may withdraw his/her bid for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of opening. All bids shall be subject to acceptance by the City during this period.

To withdraw a bid prior to the opening, the bidder shall request the withdrawal in writing. All costs associated with the withdrawal (i.e. mailing fees) will be borne by the Bidder.

VII. Award

The bid award will be based on the following:

1. Quality and performance of equipment offered.
2. Availability of equipment and parts.
3. Prior history or experience with the Bidder and equipment (if no history or experience, references are required).
4. The cost of vehicle

VIII. Rejection

The City of Bangor reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informalities or defects in bids or to accept a higher cost bid if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Bangor. The City also reserves the right to negotiate with the lowest responsive Bidder.

IX. Information for Bidders

Pages 4 through 6 of this request must be completed and returned in order to be considered.

Any exception to the provisions in the specifications must be marked in the body of this document and itemized on a separate page titled "Exceptions", referenced by section number and paragraph, along with a detailed explanation of the exception.

The entire units and all equipment must be thoroughly inspected, serviced and ready for use upon delivery. All work performed must meet established industry standards of quality to be acceptable. Any unacceptable work must be corrected before payment is issued.

All Federal and State taxes must be excluded from the bid price. A tax exemption certificate for the City of Bangor shall be furnished to the successful Bidder upon request.

X. Specifications

In this Request for Bids, a space is provided for the Bidder to answer whether they comply with the referenced section. Caution should be taken by the Bidder to ensure that all questions are answered in the spaces provided and that all information requested is provided.

2016 4x4 Yukon XL SLE or Suburban LS (operations vehicle)

Engine:

- Engine shall be a fuel injected V-8 gasoline engine, no less than 5.3 liters. This SUV shall be equipped with a heavy duty radiator and transmission cooling system.

Transmission:

- 6 speed automatic with overdrive.
- Tow/haul mode

Rear Axle:

- Limited slip axel with automatic locking differential

Brakes:

- Power brakes Single Axle ABS (if this is not possible, please advise if there is another solution that can be performed from the factory.)
- Equipped with either standard disc and/or drum brakes as long as they are maintained according to the manufacturer's performance requirements. They can also qualify if they have a single sensor ABS (anti-lock braking system) installed on the rear axle. Note: Decelerometers should not be installed on vehicles that are equipped with full ABS because the ABS tends to distort the sensitivity of the decelerometer resulting in friction readings that are lower than actually exist. In addition, differences in ABS systems result in high variations in friction readings. This could result in the premature closing of runways. A full ABS has three sensors, one on each front wheel and one on the rear axle. Decelerometers can be installed on these vehicles only if the manufacturer of the ABS approves disengagement of the sensors on the front wheels. If this modification can be satisfactorily achieved, the vehicle's brake system then becomes a single sensor ABS installed on the rear axle, which will then qualify the vehicle for conducting friction tests with decelerometers.

Steering:

- Power steering

Suspension:

- Heavy-duty suspension and shock absorbers to minimize the rocking or pitching motion during the application of brakes. The weight should be distributed equally to the front and rear axle of the vehicle.

Electrical System:

- Alternator shall be 150 amp minimum.
- Heavy duty maintenance free battery with a 750 CCA minimum.

Frame:

- Full length, one piece

Wheels:

- Wheel base: 130"
- Four 18" wheels.

Tires:

- Shall be radial tires designed for winter use. Full sized spare required
- Spare tire and wheel required

Cab:

- Full four door SUV with lifting rear door
- Fully carpeted for noise suppression
- Heavy duty cloth bucket seats 6 way power for the driver's seat with lumbar support for multiple drivers for extended shifts
- Center console that shall be removed for radio mounting console
- CD/AM/FM stereo
- Air-conditioning shall be factory installed
- Two collapsible power and heated exterior below eye line rearview mirrors
- Rear window defroster
- Interior dome lights
- Tinted rear windows to protect from outside viewing (Gun Locker)
- Power windows and door locks with cruise control (extended trips to other Airports)
- Side steps for easy access

Miscellaneous:

- Two (2) molded OEM mud flaps on front wheels
- Four (4) vent shades on all windows
- Backup camera is preferred

Roof mounted light bar:

- Tomar Scorpion or equivalent Amber LED Hi power light bar with white flood lights in place of the ally and take down lights

Pavement temperature sensor:

- Such as the surface patrol mobile infrared pavement system with the optional RS-232 output

Color:

- Exterior: Wheatland yellow, factory painted

Warranty:

- Full factory warranty as nationally advertised

Additional equipment:

- Trailer towing package

Warranty:

- Full factory warranty as nationally advertised

Manuals:

- One maintenance manual and one parts manual
- Manufactures installation, parts and operations manuals/pamphlets for all installed accessories

Radios:

- ICOM A-120 UHF programmable with 100 watt amplified external speaker mounted under hood with on off switch
- Motorola CM-300D VHF

Radio Console:

- Prefer the Havis Shield this is a vehicle specific radio mounting platform
- Duel coffee holders and arm rest
- Swivel Console tablet mount for 9" tablet or small lap top.
- Must be the longest vehicle specific console available to accommodate the Bomomk Breaking meter that will need to sit at the rear of the console.
